

VOCABULARY LIST (Ages 6 and above)

This document lists a few key words and their definitions from Bhagavad Geeta Chapter 2, “*sāṅkhya-yogaḥ*”. The definitions are based on the context of this chapter. These words have been selected from verses 1 – 38 of Chapter 2. The verse(s) where a word is present is specified next to the word in parenthesis. The vocabulary test for ages 6 and above shall be based on this list.

1. ajam अजम् (2.21)  
unborn; one who is beyond birth; eternal
2. anuśocanti अनशोचन्ति (2.11)  
lament, grieve, mourn, regret
3. āpah आपः (2.23)  
Waters
4. dahati दहति (2.23)  
burns, burns to ashes, destroys with fire
5. dharma-sammūḍhacetāḥ धर्मसमूढचेताः (2.7)  
One whose mind is confused or bewildered regarding one's duty
6. hanti हन्ति (2.19, 2.21)  
kills; destroys; harms
7. jarā जरा (2.13)  
old age
8. jīrṇāni जीर्णानि (2.22)  
old, worn-out, aged
9. kaumāram कौमारम् (2.13)  
Childhood
10. kledayanti क्लेदयन्ति (2.23)  
cause to be wet
11. mārutah मारुतः (2.23)  
the wind

12. mātrā-sparśāḥ मात्रास्पर्शः (2.14)  
the contact of the senses with the sense objects

13. navāni नवानि (2.22)  
new ones

14. nityah नित्यः (2.20)  
constant, fixed, permanent, unchanging, eternal

15. paridevanā परिदेवना (2.28)  
lamentation, complaint

16. śādhi शाधि (2.7)  
you must instruct, you must teach, you must counsel

17. samyāti संयाति (2.22)  
attains, goes towards

18. śāśvataḥ शाश्वतः (2.20)  
continuous, eternal, perpetual, incessant, uninterrupted

19. śoṣayati शोषयति (2.23)  
causes to dry

20. titikṣasva तितिक्षस्व (2.14)  
you must endure, you must tolerate, you must bear

21. tūṣṇīm तूष्णीम् (2.9)  
Silent

22. uttiṣṭha उत्तिष्ठ (2.3, 2.37)  
you arise, you stand up and fight

23. vāsāmsi वासांसि (2.22)  
garment, clothing, robes

24. yauvanam यौवनम् (2.13)  
youth, adolescence

25. yotsye योत्स्ये (2.9)  
(I) will fight
