Registration Fee due BY March 13th, 2022: \$15.00 per child per competition

Just like last year, as we have seen increased interest, we have two formats for competitions this year as well. Participants can choose to participate in either one of the two formats but NOT BOTH.

## Competition Format 1 (Memorization of the verses is optional & Memorization of the vocabulary and meaning is required)

This option is only for ages 13 & above

This competition will have two rounds. Gita Chanting round and Vocabulary round.

This competition will be held on March 19th, 2022.

For Gita Chanting, participants can chant by reading from the script (memorization is not mandatory). The following criteria will be used to judge the participants in this round and select the winners:

- 1. Proper intonation and pronunciation of the verses.
- 2. Flawless delivery.
- 3. Presentation and overall effect.

For the vocabulary test, some Samskritam words from chapter 2 are selected. They will have to memorize those words and their meanings. The participants will need to learn 25 words (PDF provided containing the words). They will be given 5 Samskritam words and they have to tell the corresponding meanings. Then they will be given 5 meanings and they have to identify the corresponding Samskritam

words. The test will be oral only. No written testing will be done. They will only be tested for correctly identifying the word and meaning pairs. They will not be tested for any additional information about the word (parts of speech, gender etc.).

The following criteria will be used to judge the participants and select the winners:

- 1. Say the correct meaning of the word.
- 2. Identify the correct word for the meaning. Will need to correctly pronounce the word to score points. This is important as at times a mispronunciation can completely change the meaning.

#### Rules for the competition

- 1. The participant will need to begin chanting from the cueing of the first two words of any verse (within the limits for the respective age group) in the chapter (can refer to the script if needed). The starting verse will depend on the cue card randomly picked by the participant.
- 2. After cueing of the first two words of any verse, if the participant is not able to chant (even after looking at the script) that participant will be disqualified.
- 3. Disqualified participants will not be given a participation prize.
- 4. From the starting verse picked by the participant, they will be required to consecutively chant the number of versus required for their age group (please refer to the last column in the table in page #2). Each participant in the group will chant the same number of verses although the starting verse could be different depending on the cue card.
- 5. The verses must be chanted in correct order.
- 6. As for the vocabulary round, the choice of words will be totally random within the confines of the vocabulary words given.

## **Competition Format 2**

## (With memorization of the verses & (for adults) meaning of the verses)

This is the traditional competition where children will memorize the versus according to their age (please refer to the table above).

This competition will be held on March 26th, 2022.

The following criteria will be used to judge the participants and select the winners:

- 1. Proper intonation and pronunciation of the verses.
- 2. Flawless delivery from memory.
- Presentation and overall effect.

#### Rules for the competition (under 21 years of age)

1. Each participant is expected to memorize all the verses for their age group as stated (please refer to the table in page #2).

- 2. The participant should be able to begin chanting from the cueing of the first two words of any verse (within the limits for the respective age group) in the chapter. The starting verse will depend on the cue card randomly picked by the participant.
- 3. After cueing of the first two words of any verse, if the participant is not able to chant that participant will be disqualified.
- 4. Disqualified participants will not be given a participation prize.
- 5. From the starting verse picked by the participant, they will be required to consecutively chant the number of versus required for their age group (please refer to the last column in the table in page #2). Each participant in the group will chant the same number of verses although the starting verse could be different depending on the cue card.
- 6. The verses must be chanted in correct order.

#### Rules for the competition (21+ years)

- 1. Each participant is expected to memorize all the verses as stated above and their meanings (please refer to the table in page #2).
- 2. The participant should be able to begin chanting from the cueing of the first two words of any verse (within the limits for the respective age group) in the chapter. The starting verse will depend on the cue card randomly picked by the participant.
- 3. From the starting verse picked by the participant, they will be required to consecutively chant 5 verses. Each participant in the group will chant the same number of verses although the starting verse could be different depending on the cue card.
- 4. The verses must be chanted in correct order.
- 5. In the next round, the participant should be able to provide the meaning of the verse when the pronouncer chants the verse. The verse number will depend on the cue card picked by the participant.
- 6. In the last round, the participant should be able to chant the verse based on the meaning of the verse provided by the pronouncer. The verse number will depend on the cue card picked by the participant.
- 7. If the participant is not able to chant the verse or recite the meaning, (s)he will lose points for that round.
- 8. Disqualified participants will not be given a participation gift.

The judges' decision will be final.
